

Digital Public Library of America

The Digital Public Library of America (DPLA https://dp.la/) is a nonprofit organization that works with libraries and cultural organizations to share knowledge. They make materials available from institutions all across the country.

Explore their Search Tips to take full advantage of the website. https://dp.la/about/search-tips

Start with family names. You can also "dig deeper and add context to the lives of our ancestors." Search for information on places

your ancestor lived, organizations they belonged to, military units or conflicts they served in, historical events that happened during their lifetimes, etc.

The website includes photographs, maps, letters, family bibles, books, and much more.

Select the list you created in the **Adding** To drop down and click the Add to **List** box for the item.


To view the item click on the title and then View Full Item.
