


You can search for books without an account. If you want to create lists you have to create a free account and sign in.


Advanced Search

- 1. Determine your search terms locations, family names, types of records, etc.
- 2. Click on Advanced Search.
- 3. Enter the search terms and click Search. You can search on a book, title, author, or key words. Try different combinations of search terms.



President Theodore Roosevelt Greets "Rough Rider"

President Theodore Roosevelt greets a former "Rough Rider" at a reunion in San Antonio, 1905. Roosevelt visited San Antonio on three occasions. Once was in 1892, when he went on a hunting trip. The next was in 1898 when he gathered and trained the Rough Riders for their military adventure in Cuba during the Spanish-American war. The last was this time, in 1905. Newspaper reports show that Teddy got very emotional at seeing "The Boys."
